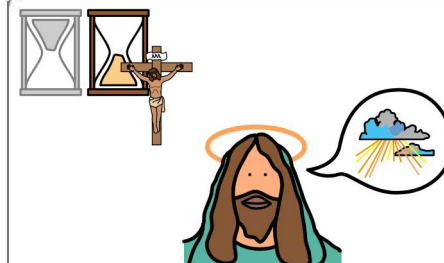
Matthew 28:16-20

Both Acts and Luke were written to a man named Theophilus to help him understand who Jesus is and how the early church began.



Luke wrote about Jesus in the Gospel of Luke and about all He did until He was taken up to Heaven.



After His suffering and death, Jesus appeared for 40 days and spoke about God's Kingdom.



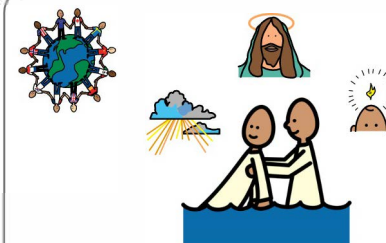
Jesus actually appeared to at least 500 people during this time.



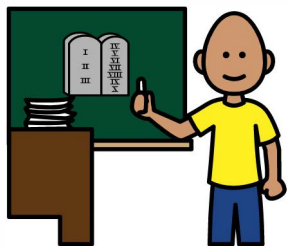
On one occasion, Jesus told His 11 disciples to meet Him on a mountain in Galilee. When they saw Him, they worshiped. But some still had doubts.



Jesus said: "All authority in Heaven and on Earth has been given to me". Then, He gave them a job assignment that still applies to us today.



Jesus said: "Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and the Holy Spirit.



Teach them to obey everything I have commanded you".



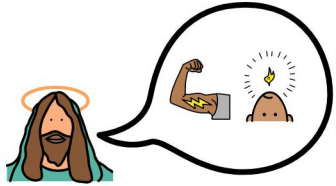
We don't have to do it alone. Jesus said He is always with us to the very end.



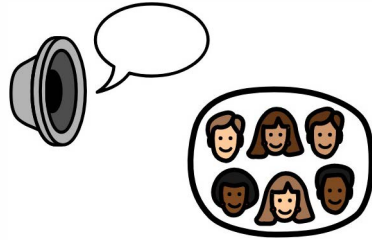
On another day, Jesus told them, "Do not leave Jerusalem, wait for the gift my Father promised. In a few days you'll be baptized with the Holy Spirit".



Soon, the Spirit would be with every person who followed Jesus. Jesus came to bring freedom to everyone.



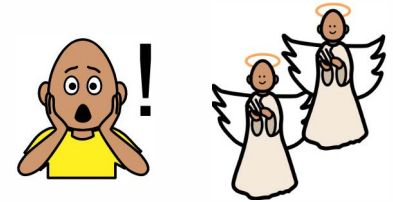
"You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. Then, you will tell all people about me in Jerusalem, all of Judea and Samaria.



You will tell people about me from one end of the Earth to the other", said Jesus.



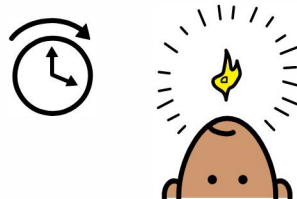
Then, Jesus was taken up into Heaven.



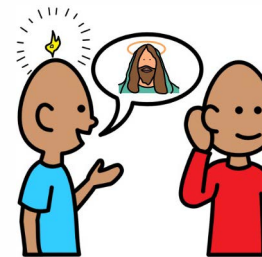
His friends stared, open-mouthed until two angels appeared beside them.

Jesus' friends shared the good news about Him starting right where they were and going to the ends of the Earth.

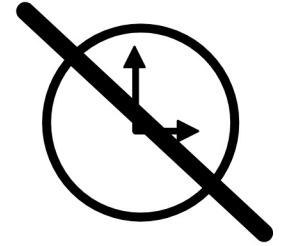
