THE WHAT

WHAT are we talking about and WHY does it matter to me? (2-4 min)

ME

- Ask a few friends and family members to answer this question for you – and share their answers with your students: *What would you say I’m known for? What’s my legacy?*

WE

- We all have reputations. We will all leave a legacy.
- Most of us would agree that a good reputation is a good thing. But what happens when our enemies set out to destroy that reputation due to jealousy and pride?

TRANSITION

- In this final session, Sadie is going to wrap up this series in Daniel 6. We’re going to learn why living a life of integrity might provoke our enemies but will always glorify God—which is what our lives are all about.

SO WHAT

So WHAT does this mean for my faith and life with God? (6-8 min)

GOD

- Before viewing the session, here are a few important things to look for in Sadie’s teaching. As you watch, pay attention to how she answers the following questions.
 - According to Sadie, what is the theme of this session?
 - In what ways is King Darius different from King Nebuchadnezzar? Why is this difference important to the story?
