MINISTRY ROLE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Build relationships with students in attendance of reach events to help ensure they're known by someone in the church
- Welcome new students
- Prepare and be willing to help students understand what it means to accept Jesus as their personal Savior
- Help MSM Campus Pastor with other tasks to have a successful Squad Night
- Invite and recruit volunteers to serve in Student Ministry

ROLE REQUIREMENTS:

- Pursue a lifestyle that reflects Hope's Five Marks of Discipleship
- Demonstrate Hope's values
- Have a heart for reaching lost students and loving them wherever they are in their faith
- Attend regularly scheduled meetings and training
- Must be a high school student or older
- Complete a background check

PERSONAL GROWTH OPPORTUNITIES:

- Spiritual Development: Model a growing relationship with Jesus, able to articulate the gospel
- Vision: Champion and implements Hope & HSM vision
- Strategy: Unite others around them and implement ministry strategy
- Collaboration: Recruit and delegate appropriately
- Equipping: Recognize and encourage strengths in others
- Stewardship: Faithfully steward personal giftedness and time of self and others

- I will attend other MSM events during the year outside of mid-week reach events as I can.
- I will read weekly emails and pay attention to announcements on the Group Me app.
- I will actively pursue growing in my leadership skills by: attending huddles and occasional leader trainings. If I miss them, I will pursue the material needed.
- I will commit to serve for a full school year (June-July). In the spring I will talk with my coach and/or Student Ministry staff member to let them know if I'll continue to serve a second year or step down.
