THE WIN:

TIME INVESTMENT: VARIES (USUALLY 1-2 HOURS A WEEK)

MINISTRY ROLE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Smile and welcome students to ministry events
- Assist with weekly check-in for students
- Connect new students to volunteer adults, preferably their appropriate small group leader
- Possibly help with snack shop
- Invite and recruit volunteers to serve in Student Ministry

ROLE REQUIREMENTS:

- Pursue a lifestyle that reflects Hope's Five Marks of Discipleship
- Demonstrate Hope's values
- Attend all regularly scheduled meetings and trainings
- Grow in your ability to lead yourself
- Must be a high school student or older
- Complete a background check
- Must be able to stand for at least two hours

PERSONAL GROWTH OPPORTUNITIES:

- Spiritual Development: Know the gospel and take responsibility for personal growth
- Vision: Know the vision of Hope and how your role supports it
- Strategy: Work effectively in area of assignment
- Collaboration: Work well with others
- Equipping: Know and work out of personal strengths
- Stewardship: Faithfully steward personal giftedness and resources
