# LEADER PREP

### MAIN POINT Don't compare your worth with their posts.

### SCRIPTURE

Proverbs 4:23 NIV 2 Corinthians 10:12 NLT

#### **GOAL OF SMALL GROUP**

To inspire students to find their worth and identity in God's love for them rather than in comparing ourselves to others.

### THINK ABOUT THIS

Our students need to know they are worth way more than however many likes they get on their posts. Whether they are trending on social media or in the halls of their high school or not, they are worth so much that the God of the Universe sent His son to die to rescue them.

### Affirm your students'

**value** to you, to God, and to the world over and over again.

Consistently and unconditionally remind your students that they matter.

- How can we remind ourselves that we matter to God? (Hand out You Matter to God Bible Verses)
- How would you encourage a friend to find their worth in what God says about them?

- How can small groups be a safe place for us not to compare ourselves to each other but to encourage each other?
- How can we connect outside of small group time and have fun together?
