#### **STEP 1: READ THE BIBLE**

Yessss! We are glad you are here because taking time on your own to study God's word is an amazing way to grow in your relationship with Him. Life with Jesus is the best life! Take a moment to pray and ask God to lead you as you study this Scripture; then read the Scripture

#### **STEP 2: OBSERVE**

#### STEP 3: INTERPRET

Research answers using trusted sources like a Study Bible, BibleProject.com, BlueLetterBible.org, and/or Bible.org 1. What is the historical and/or cultural context of this Scripture?

2. What else do I know about the author, audience, or context of this passage?

- 3. What do key words mean in their original language?
- 4. What other Scripture might help me interpret this text?
- 5. What is this text's clearest meaning?

#### STEP 4: APPLICATION GET PERSONAL

- How do you relate to any of the characters, events, or words in this Scripture?
- 2. What truth(s) from this Scripture can you apply to your life right now?
- 3. What is God saying to you through this Scripture?

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
