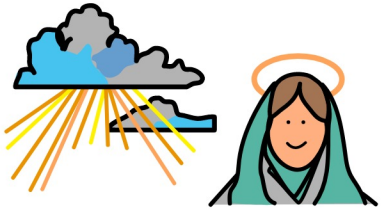
This week we learn about Mary, an ordinary girl that was

"The Lord has blessed you in a special way. He is with you.



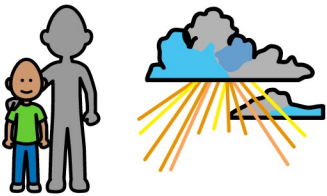
Do not be afraid. God is pleased with you.

The Angel said,

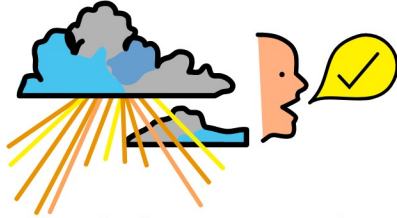


"The Holy Spirit will make it happen." The angel continued to say,

"You know your cousin, Elizabeth? She will have a child even though she is old..."



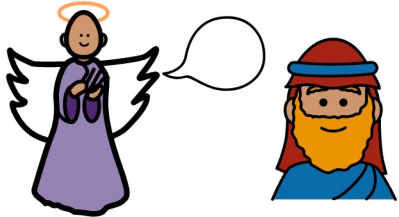

The angel told him not to be afraid



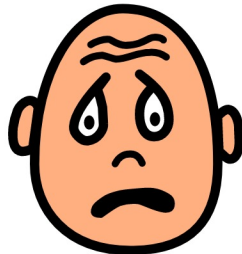
to take Mary as his wife. The angel continued..



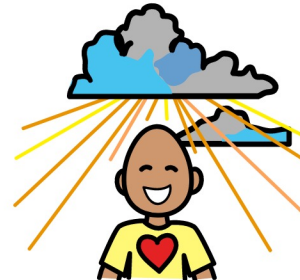

they trusted God and had peace

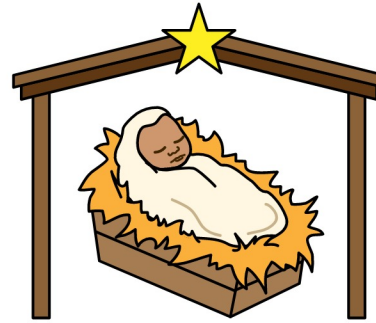
