- Moses grew up in the household of Pharaoh, the king of Egypt. (true)
- God spoke to Moses through a tree that was covered in flowers. (False: God spoke to Moses through a burning bush.)
- Moses thought he could easily lead the Israelites out of Egypt. (False: Moses was afraid and didn't believe he could do it.)
- When Moses threw his walking stick on the ground, it turned into a snake. (true)
- God said, "I will be with you," to reassure Moses. (true)
- Moses felt confident in his speaking abilities and didn't need any help. (False: Moses said he wasn't a good speaker, and God sent Aaron to help him.)
- Pharaoh immediately agreed to let the Israelites go when Moses asked. (False: Pharaoh only let the Israelites go after God sent lots of plagues.)
- The Israelites were slaves in Egypt for a long, long time. (true)
- God made Moses perfectly suited to lead the Israelites out of Egypt. (true)
- Uniqueness is about doing things exactly the same way as everyone else. (False: Uniqueness is about learning more about yourself so you can make a difference.)
- Moses was perfect and never made any mistakes. (False: Moses wasn't perfect, but God still used him to make a big difference.)
- When we follow Jesus, God sends the Holy Spirit to help us make a difference. (true)
