
Paul and Silas were walking to their place of prayer when a girl said: "These men serve the Most High God. They are telling you how to be saved."

The city judges called for Paul and Silas to be whipped and thrown in prison.




Paul and Silas were chained by their feet. They talked to God and sang loudly.




A powerful earthquake shook the prison and the doors were opened.

Paul and Silas left.





