ABOUT THIS WEEK

- "If you could belong to any group in the world—real or fictional—what would it be and why?"
- Last week we challenged each other to write down where we've seen or shared the love of Jesus. Does anyone want to share their experiences with us?

Discussion Questions:

- Why do you think Paul compares the church to a body? What stands out to you about this image?
- What does this passage teach us about the importance of our unique gifts and abilities?
- How can we celebrate both our differences and our unity in following Jesus?
- How does this image of a unified church challenge how we treat others in our faith community?

Challenge Question:

• "What is one way you can help others feel like they matter this week?"

Praver

Share Requests:

- "Who in your life needs to know they belong to Jesus or to this group?"
- Encourage students to share prayer requests for themselves or others.

Group Prayer:

Thank Jesus for giving us a place to belong, and pray for those who feel disconnected.

Discipleship Moment

You Belong Here: Ask students to think of one friend they can encourage this week and one person they can invite to feel more included in their community.

Partner Check-In: Pair students to share their reflections and check in with each other before the next meeting.
