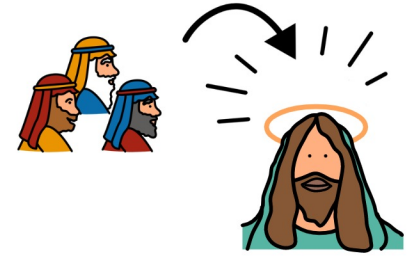
When Jesus started to travel, teach, and heal people;

Jesus expected His disciples to spend their time with Him,



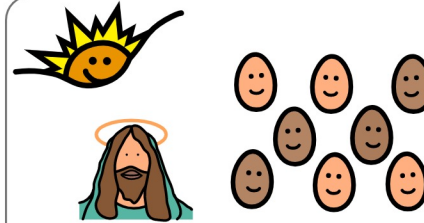
to become more like Him,



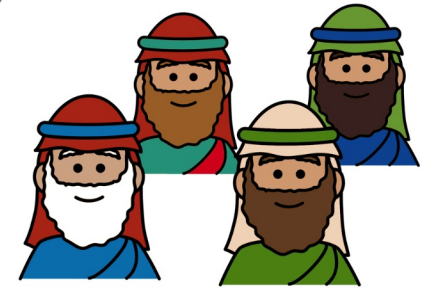
and together to do the work that He did.

When morning came, Jesus called the crowd who had been following Him and chose 12 men to be His disciples.



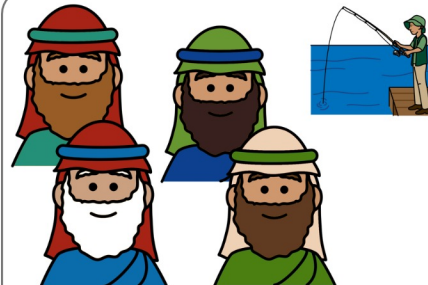
- Simon Peter, Andrew, James and John

- James (son of Alphaeus), Simon (the Zealot), Judas (son of James), and Judas Iscariot.

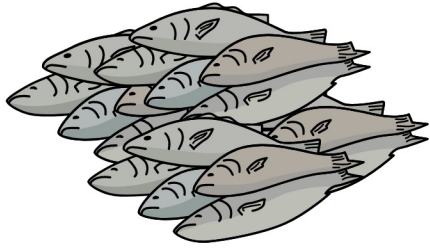


Simon Peter, Andrew, James, and John were all fishermen.

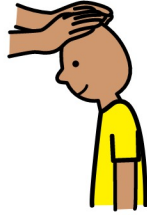


Jesus borrowed Peter's boat to teach from and instructed Peter to throw out his nets in the same place he caught nothing all night.

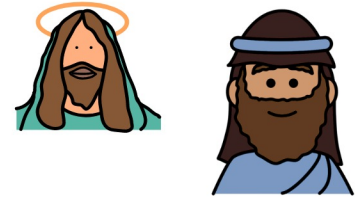
The men caught so many fish they almost sunk the boat.



From that day on, they became fishers of people.



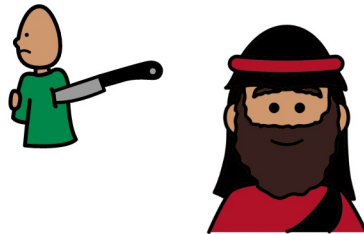
Matthew was a tax collector. He was in charge of taking money from the Jewish people to give to their enemies.



No one liked tax collectors. Jesus walked up to him and even ate with him. Matthew became a disciple.



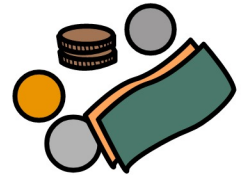
Simon was part of a revolutionary group that wanted to overthrow Romans using violence. He too became a disciple.

Jesus knew that the more time these people spent with Him,

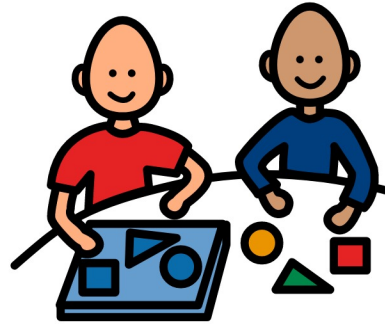
