When morning came, the 2 armies met on the field of battle




while Moses, his brother Aaron, and their friend Hur stood atop a nearby hill.

Aaron and Hur found a large rock for Moses to sit on, then they stood alongside him




and held his hands up for him.

instead, Aaron and Hur worked together to help Moses






and all of God's people win the battle.
