WEEK 1

- BIG IDEA: Sin is the way that leads to death.
- BIBLE: Genesis 3:1-6; Isaiah 53:6; Romans 6:23; James 5:16; Ephesians 2:4-5

Because of sin, we were deserving of a punishment. But, God loves us so much that He sent Jesus to die in our place. This week, we'll take a look at a man named Barabbas to illustrate how Jesus took on the punishment we deserved in order to give us a way back to God.

- BIG IDEA: Jesus made His way to the Cross, so that we can have a way to God.
- BIBLE: Matthew 27:15-26; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Ephesians 2:4-5
