A rich man was leaving on a long journey.



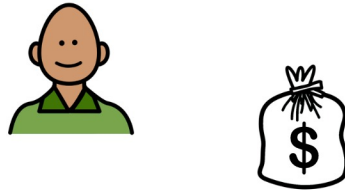
He sent for his servants and handed each of them some money to take care of while he was gone.



To the FIRST servant he gave 5 talents or bags of gold.



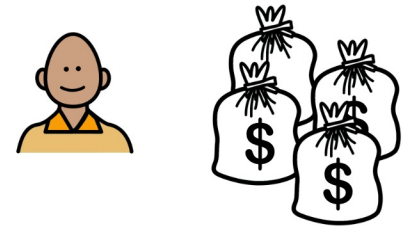
To the SECOND servant he gave 2 talents



and to the THIRD servant he gave 1 talent.



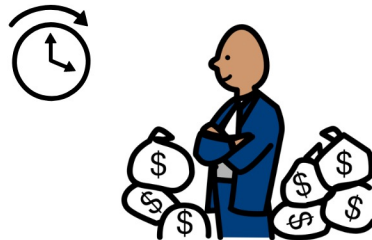
The servant with 5 talents went out at once and put the money to work. He invested well and earned 5 more bags of gold.

The man who had received 5 bags handed over all the extra gold he had earned. A total of 10 bags.



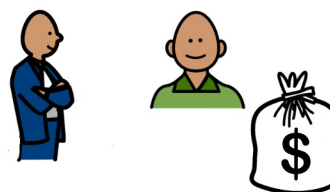
The man with 2 bags handed over what he had earned as well. Both men did well and were praised.



But the THIRD servant clutched the bag he had dug up from the backyard.



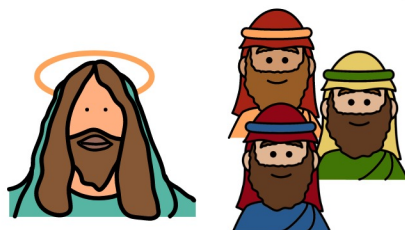
He was afraid and hid the gold in the ground.



He returned exactly what was given to him. He did not get the response he was looking



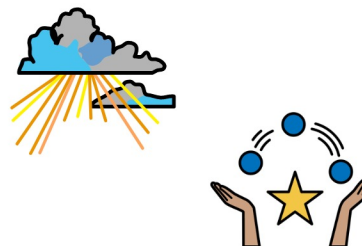
The master ordered to get his talents taken away and give them to the man with the 10 bags of gold.



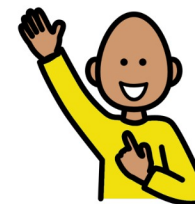
What Jesus wanted His disciples and us to hear is simple.



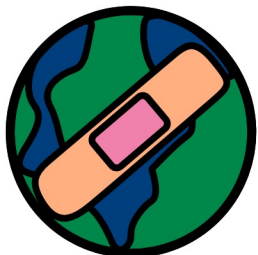
The story was talking about talents in terms of money.



God has given us unique talents and experiences.

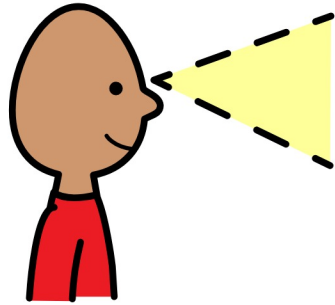
