God gave a special sign to John the Baptist. He saw the Holy Spirit come down from heaven like a dove.




The spirit remainded on Jesus. He was God's chosen one.

"Look, the Lamb of God", John the Baptist said.




Andrew and John went to catch up with Jesus and spent the rest of the day with Him.






Andrew and John were drawn to Jesus. They were convinced and amazed by Him.




Andrew ran to tell his brother Simon.

Peter means "rock".




Peter would go on to be solid and strong as a rock in building the early church.

Philip couldn't contain the news and found his friend Nathaniel to tell him about Jesus.




