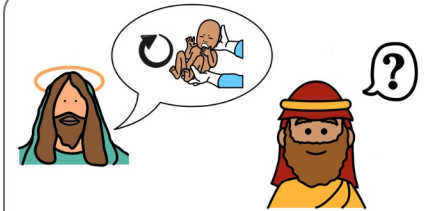
Religious leaders were trying to figure out who Jesus was.



One of the religious leaders was a man named Nicodemus. He truly wanted to learn the truth about Jesus.



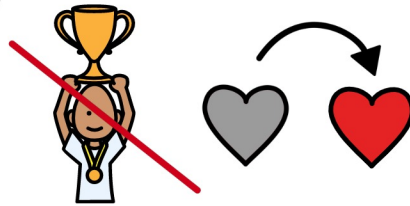
Nicodemus was scared about what the others might think so he arranged to meet with Jesus at night.



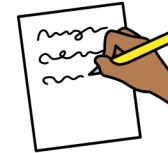
Jesus said, "No one can see God's kingdom unless they are born again". Nicodemus did not understand.

will not die, but will have eternal life."

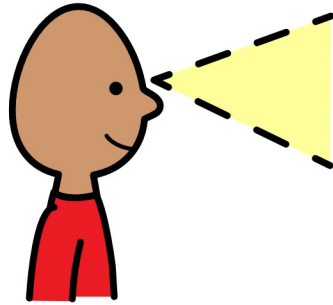


God did not send His Son into the world to judge the world.

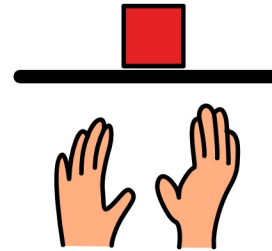
