One of the religious leaderes was a man named Nicodemus. He truly wanted to learn the truth about Jesus.






Nicodemus was scared about what the others might think so he arranged to meet with Jesus at night.

Nicodemus and the other religious leaders knew that God had promised to send a rescuer, but they were looking for a powerful leader to fight against the Romans.




God's kingdom is not about winning battles, it's about changing hearts.

God did not send His Son into the world to judge the world.


