Gospel Follow Up

Talk with the kids: Review the Gospel Story & talk about possible responses to hearing the Good News.

First: Use the images to remind the kids of what they just learned and talk through the Gospel.



God LOVED

God loves us! Even though we choose to sin, he LOVES us!



God GAVE

God gave us his son Jesus to take the



We BELIEVE

We believe that we can't be our own rescuer. punishment of our sin. We believe that we need a savior, and that is Jesus!



We RECEIVE

We receive the gift of eternal life with God, by trusting the the only way to have a right relationship with God is by believing Jesus is our Savior and trusting God with our life.

Second: Use the emojis to help the kids understand what these *possible* responses mean.



I'm good, I don't have any questions right now.



I am curious about what it means to have a relationship with Jesus. I still have some questions.



I decided today to believe Jesus is my savior and trust God with my life.



I made the decision to follow Jesus already. (Sometime before today.)

Third: Remind Students- accepting Jesus as your Savior and trusting God with your life is a decision you only have to make one time. BUT... it does mean that every day you make choices to reflect that decision- love others, treat others the way you want to be treated...

If you have a student share with you that they made that decision today, take the opportunity to write that child's name down and share that with your classroom coach, and try to talk to the parent of that child who made a decision to follow Jesus to let them know!
