Discussion Questions:

- In Genesis 1, what job did God give humanity? What does that say about your purpose as a person made in His image?
- How does the "new creation" described in Revelation 21 give us hope for what God is doing? And how do we get to be a part of it now?
- Jesus calls peacemakers blessed in Matthew 5:9. What do you think it actually means to make peace in a world full of drama, anxiety, and division?
- Where in your life right now do you see chaos? What would it look like to bring God's peace into that space?

Make it Real:

- Have you ever had to step into a difficult situation, conversation, or space to bring peace to a chaotic relationship? What was that like?
- Does anyone have a situation like that they're currently going through? How can we encourage and pray for you?

Discipleship Moment:

• The Internal Chaos: Sometimes the chaos we face isn't around us, it's within us. This week, when you feel overwhelmed or life feels chaotic, pray and ask God for guidance and peace. Write about it and be ready to share next week.

Group Prayer:

Pray for God to reveal His peace in our lives and to send us out as peacemakers.
