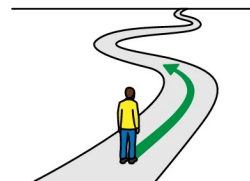
God chose a man named Abram and his wife Sarai, years before they had started on a journey to the land of Canaan with Abram's father and nephew.

When Abram was 75 years old, God spoke to him, "Abram, go from your country, your people and your father's family.



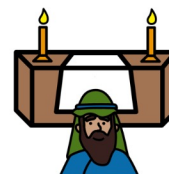
Go to the land I will show you. I will make you a great nation and I will bless you..."



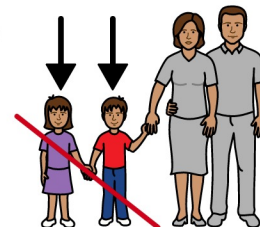
Abram and Sarai believed God, so they packed up everything they owned and started on an epic trip along with Abram's nephew Lot and all of their flocks and herds.



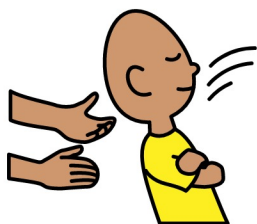
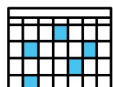

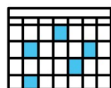
Abram and Sarai traveled east and built their tent near Bethel. Abram built another altar there.



Years passed and still Abram and Sarai had no child.



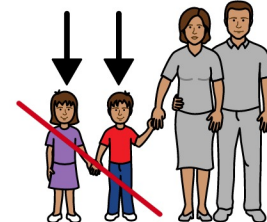
Sometimes they trusted God

God appeared to Abram in a vision and said, "Abram, do not be afraid, I am like a shield to you. I am your very great reward."

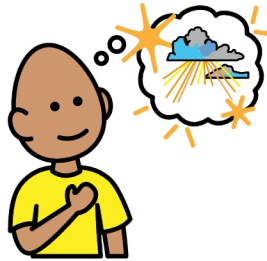


Abram wanted to believe, but his heart was heavy. Abram said, "Lord and King, what can you give me, I still don't have children."

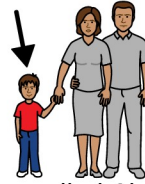

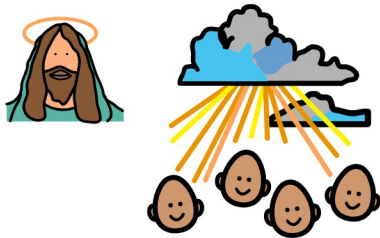
Abram chose to keep believing

when God gave them Isaac.

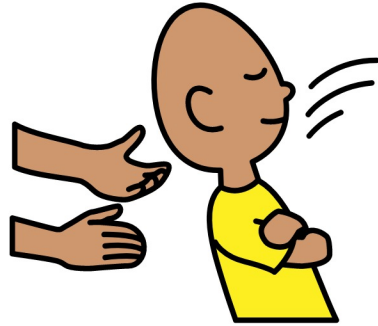


Abraham's family became a great

son - Jesus.

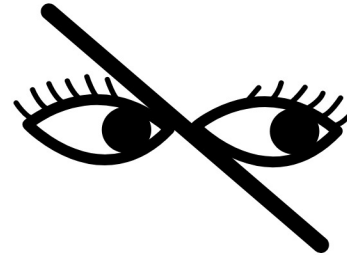


Through Jesus, the entire world

promised.

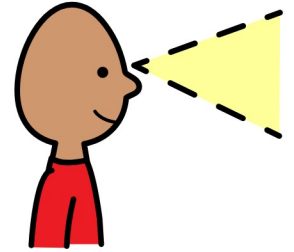
