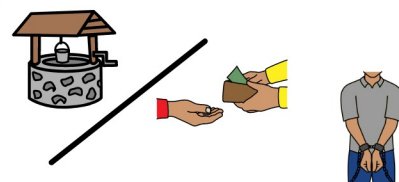
Abraham's grandson Jacob had 12 sons and 1 daughter.



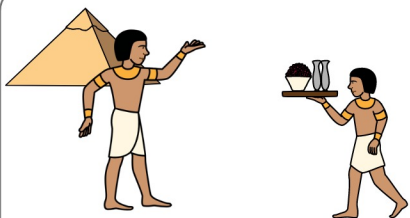
Jacob had a favorite, his second to youngest son, Joseph. Jacob showed that by giving him a colorful robe and soon Jacob started to act like a main character.



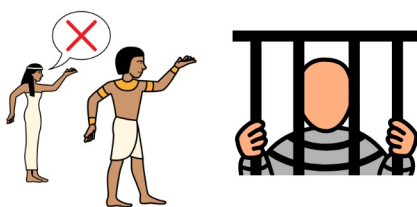
He told his brothers about 2 dreams God gave him. Dreams showing that one day, his whole family will bow down before him. That did not go over well.



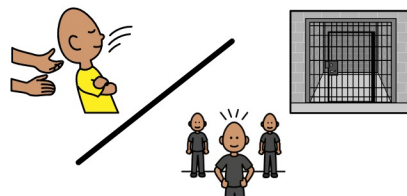
Joseph's brothers had enough and threw him over an empty well. They sold him to traders that took him to Egypt to be enslaved.



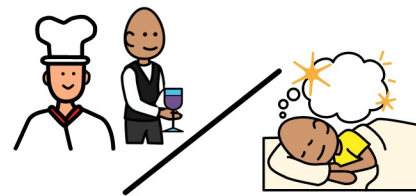
In Egypt, Joseph was put to work in the house of Potiphar, who served as captain of the guard for Pharaoh, the King.

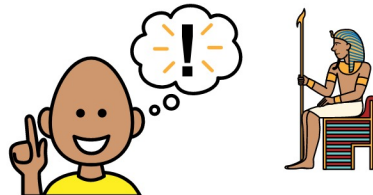
But even in prison, Joseph trusted that God was still with him. He kept working hard and soon, the jailer put him in charge of the other prisoners.



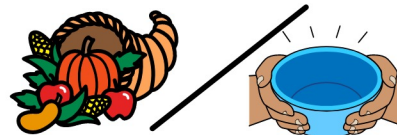
One day, 2 prisoners - Pharaoh's baker and wine taster, had strange dreams. With God's help, Joseph told them the meaning of those dreams.



The wine taster was freed from prison, just as Joseph saw in the dream. He promised to help Joseph, but he forgot.



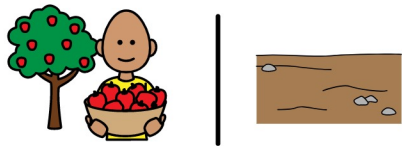
2 years later, Pharaoh himself had strange dreams and that's when the wine taster finally remembered Joseph.

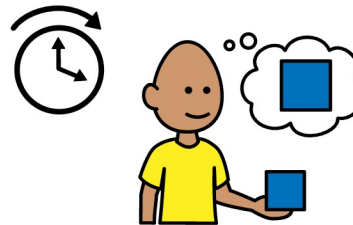
Pharaoh put Joseph in charge of this. Straight from prison, Joseph was put second in command over all of Egypt.



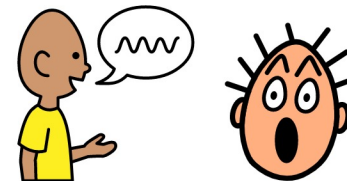
For 7 years of good harvests Joseph instructed the people to store up food. Then just as God said, a time came when the crops failed. Everyone came to Joseph for food.



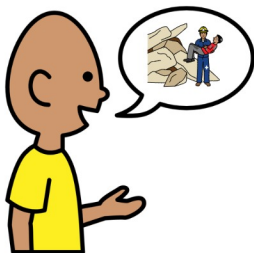
Joseph's family also had no food. Jacob sent his sons to Egypt to get food. Twice.



After all those years, the brothers didn't recognize Joseph, but he recognized them.



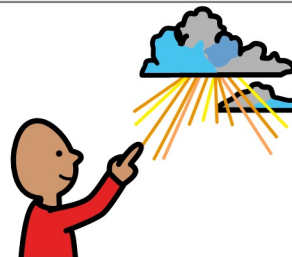
Joseph did not reveal himself to them right away, but when he finally told them, the brothers were terrified.



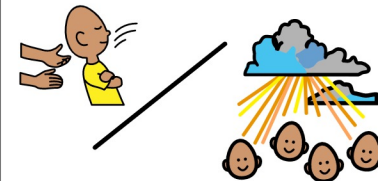
Joseph told them to not be angry with themselves. God had sent him ahead to save many lives.



Joseph instructed them to bring Jacob and all their families to Egypt so they would have food to eat for the remaining 5 years of famine.

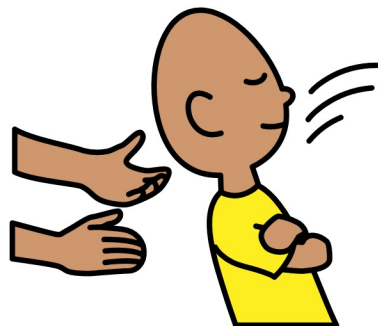


Joseph told his brothers, "You planned to harm me, but God planned it for good."

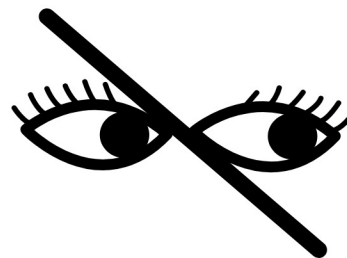


Because Joseph continued to trust God when things got tough, God used Joseph to save his entire family.

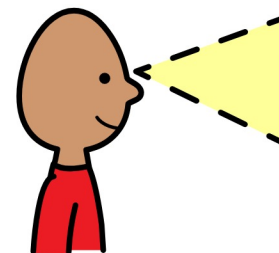
