In the beginning, God was there. He created the Heavens and the earth. He created day and night.



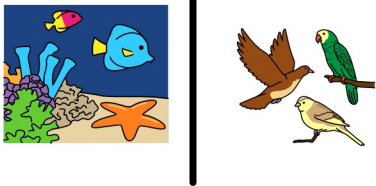
On Day 2: God created the sky.



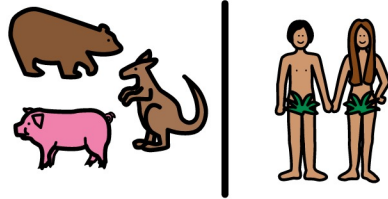
On Day 3: God created dry land and plants.



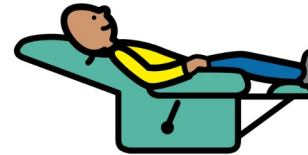
On Day 4: God created the sun, the moon and the stars.



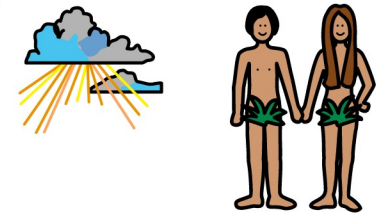
On Day 5: God created sea creatures and birds.



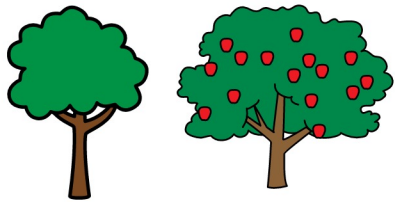
On Day 6: God created land animals and humans.



On Day 7: God rested.



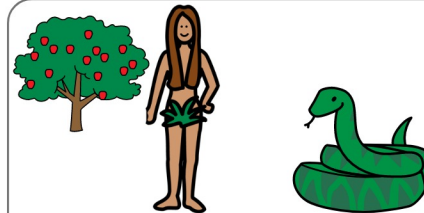
Adam and Eve were happy to take care of the Garden of Eden, their home. They walked and talked with God as close friends.



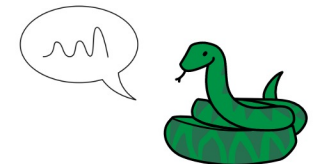
In the center of the garden stood two special trees - The Tree of Life and The Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil.



God said, "You must not eat the fruit from the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil, if you do, you will certainly die."

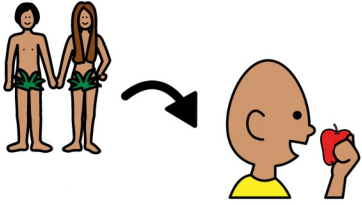


That was the only rule. One day, a sneaky serpent showed up. The serpent twisted God's words.

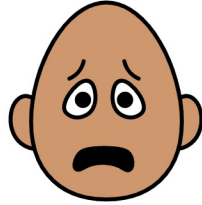


The serpent told Eve that if she ate from the tree she would not die, but know things she did not know before and be like God.

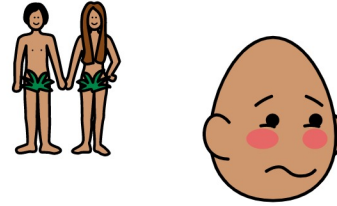

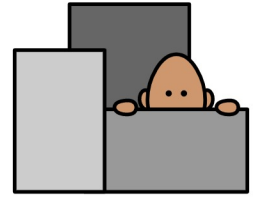
Eve gave in and ate from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. She gave Adam the fruit and he ate too.



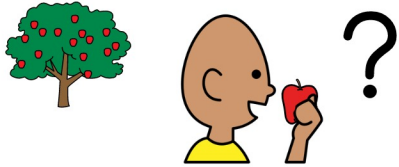
Adam and Eve now knew things they did not know before. They felt fear and questioned their trust for each other and God.



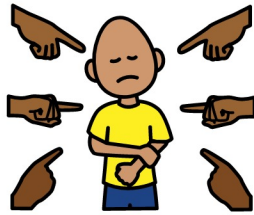
They were embarrassed to be naked so they made clothes out of fig leaves.



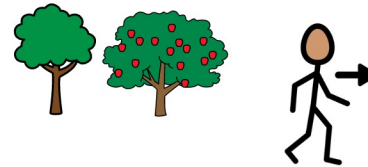
When they heard God, they were afraid because they were naked and decided to hide.



"Have you eaten from the tree I commanded you not to eat from?", God said to Adam and Eve.



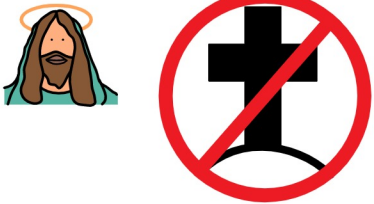
Adam blamed Eve. Eve blamed the serpent for tricking her into eating the fruit. The truth is, both Adam and Eve were to blame.



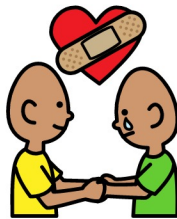
God told Adam and Eve that their lives would be difficult now and even though He still loved them, He sent them away from the garden.



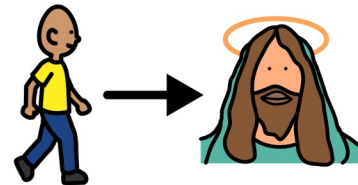
God remained faithful. He already had a plan to one day make things right again - Jesus!



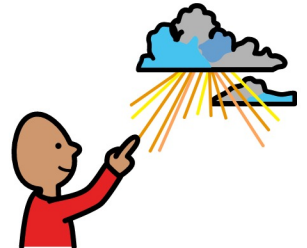
Because of Jesus, sin was defeated and death is no longer the end.



When we ask God to forgive the wrong things we've done,

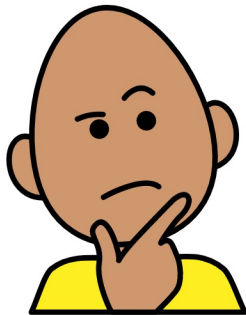
