The Israelites were filled with joy to be free at last! But the celebration quickly turned to fear



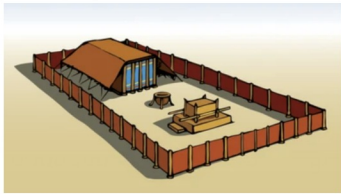
and complaining when they realized they were surrounded by wilderness with no food or water.



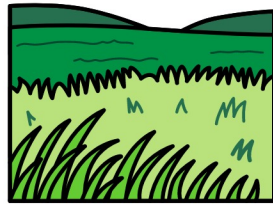
God continued to provide for them bringing water out of rock and sending 'manna', bread that fell from heaven each morning.



God called Moses to the top of Mount Sinai and gave him rules to help people follow God - The 10 Commandments.



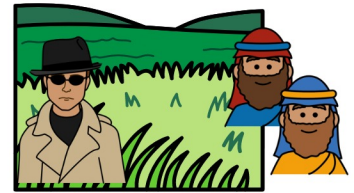
God even came down to live among the people in a special tent called The Tabernacle.



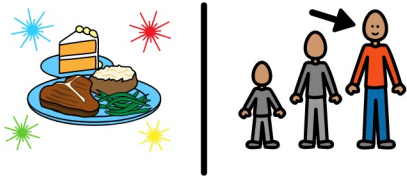
After 2 years in the wilderness, the Israelites reached the edge of the land God had promised to them - Canaan.



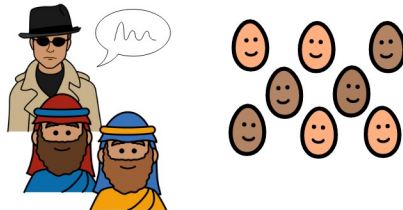
The Lord told Moses to send 1 leader from each of the 12 tribes to check out the land. 12 men were sent as spies.



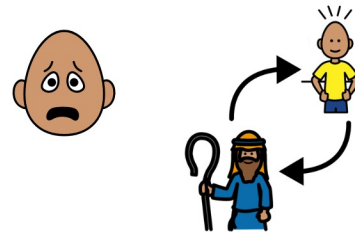
The 12 spies snuck into the land of Canaan and traveled all over for 40 days. Joshua and Caleb were 2 of the spies sent by Moses.



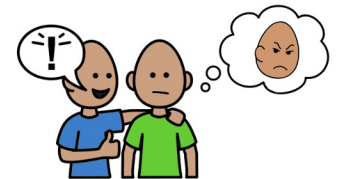
The spies discovered two things: (1) food growing in the land was amazing, and (2) the people of the land were tall, strong and lived in well-guarded towns.



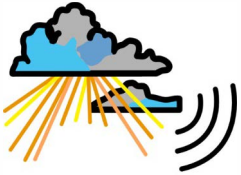
At the end of 40 days, the spies crossed back to the Israelite camp and told everyone what they had found.



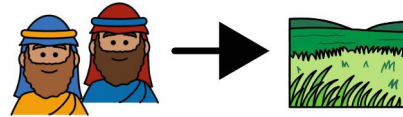
They did not listen to Joshua and Caleb, but focused on their fears. They even talked about finding a new leader to replace Moses.



Joshua and Caleb tried to encourage the Israelites, but the people got so fearful and angry they even talked about killing Joshua and Caleb.



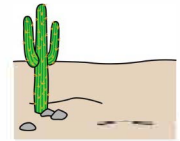
That's when the glory of the Lord appeared. "I promised to make this land your home, but now not all of you will enter the land," said the Lord.



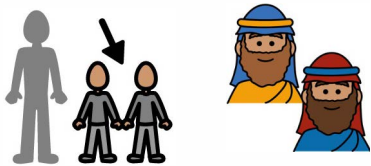
"Caleb will enter it, so will Joshua. They are the only ones," said the Lord.



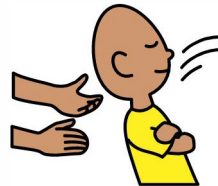
The Israelites refused to listen and were quickly defeated when they tried to take over the land.

Only their children would enter the land along with Joshua and Caleb, who had chosen to be brave

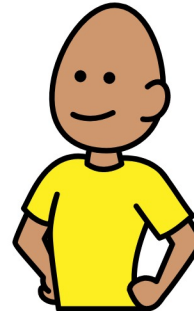


and trust God even when no one else did.

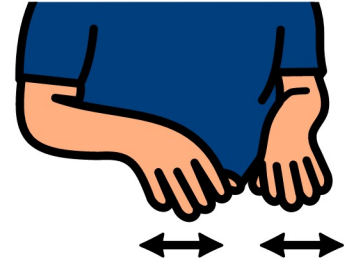
