ABOUT THIS WEEK

This week we'll see how being part of the church is more than just showing up on Sundays. The early church devoted themselves to teaching, fellowship, meals, prayer, and generosity—and God used that to grow His kingdom. When we make church involvement a priority, we learn to put others first and invite people into the story of Jesus.

- The early church shared what they had with each other. How could we do something like that in our group today?
- What's one way you think we could make new people feel welcome when they come to youth group?

Challenge Question:

• If someone new walked into MSM this week, what's one specific thing you can do to make them feel like they belong?

• Ask for any prayer requests or praises to celebrate together.

Group Prayer:

- Encourage students to pray briefly for each other's requests.
- Close by asking God to remind you of how you can love others in our church.
