David was the youngest son, responsible for taking care of the sheep.



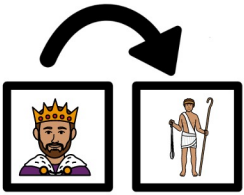
He had to learn how to protect the sheep. Out in the fields, he learned the beauty of creation and the God who made everything.



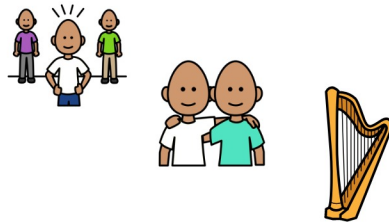
David played the harp making his own poems and songs.



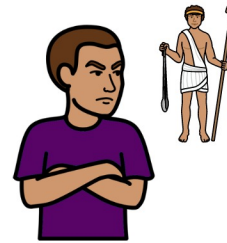
During this time, David was a shepherd and King Saul lead Israel. Saul made choices out of pride and fear.



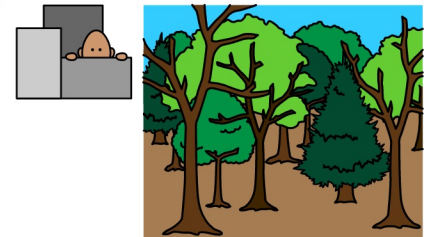
God chose David as the next King. With God's help David defeated Goliath and King Saul was so impressed.



He invited David to be a leader in his army. David became best friends with Jonathan, King Saul's son and played music for Saul.



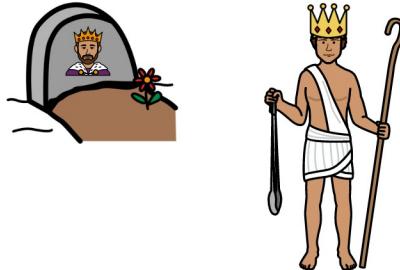
As David became more and more popular, Saul became jealous of David and even tried to kill him.



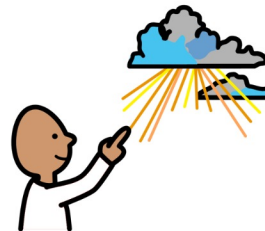
David had to go into hiding. For years, David lived on the run from Saul in the wilderness.

Eventually, Saul was killed in battle and David became King.



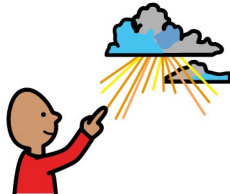
Though David did not always act wisely, he always chose to turn back to God.



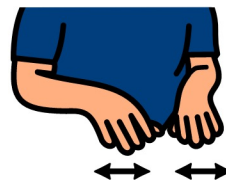
He continued to focus on God's promises and what He had done for the people.

In the Psalms we discover the wisdom of bringing everything to God.



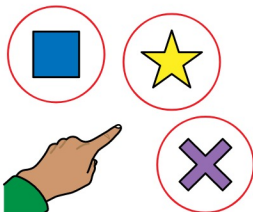
In Psalm 1, we see that wise people do 2 things:

and (2) focus on God's word.

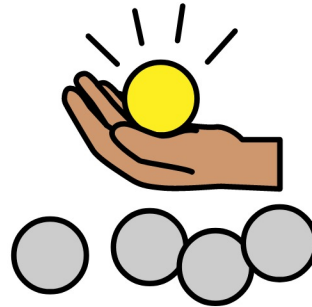


When you are rooted in God's Word, you can choose wisely when hard times come.

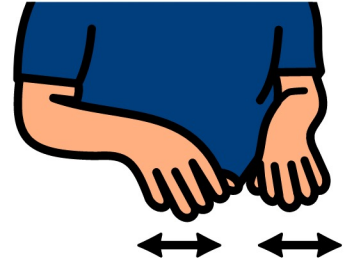
