





BASIC TRUTH

ACTIVITY TIME

START HERE

These activities are not meant to be all done every week by everyone. Instead, choose one or more that make sense for the dynamics of the day. Even if you can only do the same activity for the entire month - that is a win!

BIBLE STORY REVIEW ACTIVITIES

STORY TRAIN

Put the story pictures around the room. Either as a group or one-on-one with a child, 'choo-choo' from one picture to the next in order.

LITTLE PEOPLE RETELL

Use Little People figures (or similar) to retell the story.

BASIC TRUTH ACTIVITIES

BASIC TRUTH SONG

Play or sing the Basic Truth Song.

BUILD A TOWER

Use blocks or colored rings and stack them. As you are building together say, 'I am MADE by God for a purpose!' Knock it down and build it up again repeating the Basic Truth.

CRAFT

MARY AND THE ANGEL CRAFT FOR WALKERS AND ABOVE

Use the washable ink pads to stamp the child's hand. Then place their hands on either side of the angel to form wings. Quickly use the wet wipes to wipe the ink off of their hands. Allow them to color their angel if they want.
