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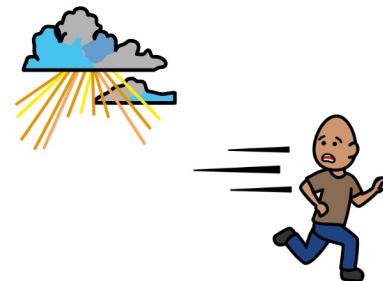
The prophet Jonah lived in the times of Jeroboam II, one of the worst Kings of the Northern Kingdom of Israel.

One day, God spoke to Jonah and told him to go to the great city of Nineveh and preach there.



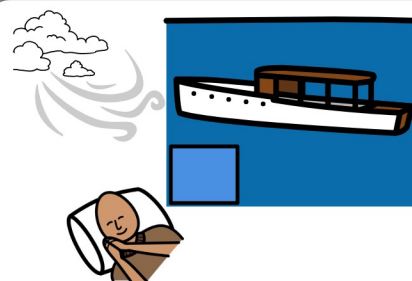
Jonah decided to run away from God.



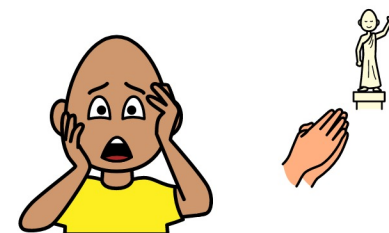
Instead of heading Northeast towards Nineveh, Jonah went to the harbor of Joppa and hopped on a boat heading towards Tarshish.



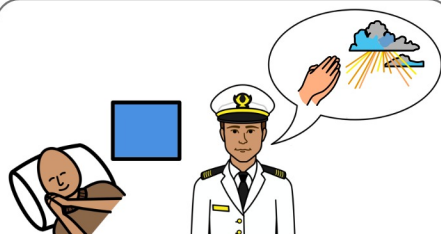
Jonah went as far as he could in the opposite direction.



Jonah went below deck for a nap. While he was sleeping, God sent a wild wind. The sailors panicked.



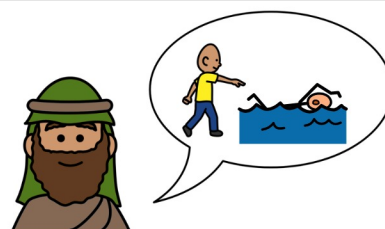
The sailors panicked and cried out to the false gods they worshiped.



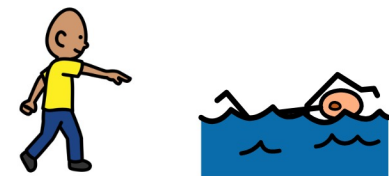
The captain hauled Jonah out of bed. "How can you sleep? Call out to your God for help", the captain said.



Jonah confessed that he was running away from God.



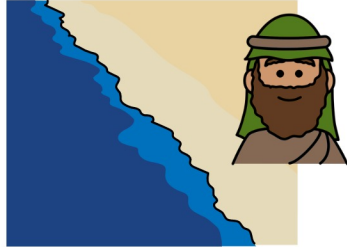
The sea was getting higher and the sailors were terrified. Jonah asked them to throw him in the sea.



The sailors did not want to do this, but the storm was getting worse. They picked Jonah up and threw him overboard. The sea became calm.



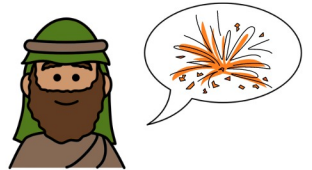
God sent a giant fish to swallow Jonah whole. For 3 days and 3 nights, Jonah was stuck in the belly of the fish. He cried out to God.



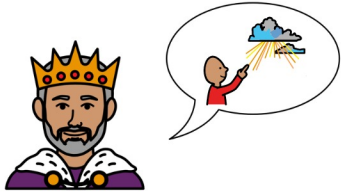
At the end of 3 days, the Lord made the fish swim to shore and spit out Jonah on dry land.



God told Jonah to go to Nineveh and announce to people the message He would give him.



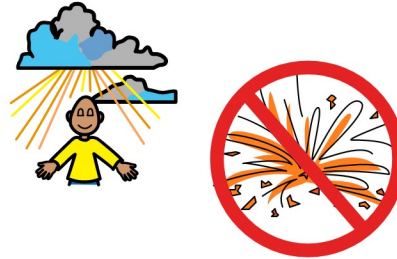
Jonah went to Nineveh and told the people that in 40 days Nineveh would be destroyed. This was bad news, but the people listened.



The King sent out a message to the whole city to call out to God and stop doing what is evil.



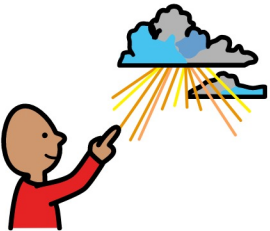
The people did what the King commanded. They turned to God and stopped doing wrong things.



God saw this and showed great mercy. He did not destroy the city.

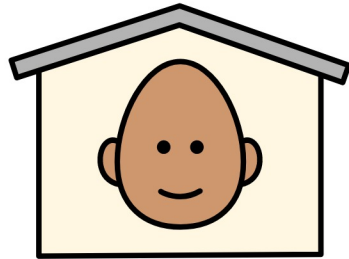


Jonah sulked because God had chosen to show love to even the enemies of Israel.

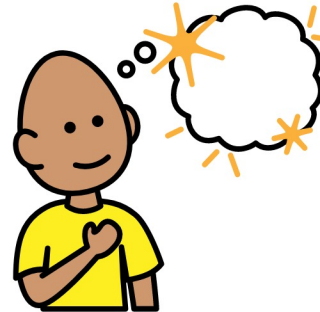
