As followers of Jesus, we model the way of Jesus for one another.

BIBLE

Philippians 2:1-5

ABOUT THIS WEEK

Over the past two weeks, we've talked about what it means to follow Jesus and why we need trusted leaders to help us grow. This final week invites students to recognize that discipleship doesn't stop with being taught—it continues as we help shape one another. Following Jesus means adopting His mindset and allowing our lives to point others toward Him through humility, love, and intentional example.

Let's Break the Ice // Discipleship Moment Follow Up :

- Last week, we challenged you to initiate a conversation with a trusted leader. How did it go?
- On to this week, when do you feel most aware that someone else is watching you?

Bible Study:

- Read Together: As a group, read Philippians 2:3-5 NIV

Discussion Questions:

- What attitudes does Paul call believers to have toward one another?
- How does Paul describe the mindset of Christ in this passage?
- Why is humility so countercultural, especially in high school?
- How do our everyday choices influence the faith of others?
- What's the difference between being an example and trying to be perfect?

Make it Real:

- Do you feel like the type of Christian worth following? Why or why not?
- Who might God be asking you to intentionally disciple in your life right now?

Discipleship Moment:

- Modeling Jesus Practice:

Challenge students to intentionally **serve someone** this week—at home, at school, or in their friend group—without seeking recognition.

- **Partner Check-In (optional):** Pair students up and have them commit to checking in with their partner either sometime during the week or during your next gathering.

Prayer

Share Requests:

- Ask for any prayer requests or praises to celebrate together.

Group Prayer:

- Pray together that God would help each student see the opportunities to disciple others by their actions.
