Leader Summary

In Week 3, Jesus singles out Zacchaeus, a tax collector who has scrambled up a tree for a better view. Instead of scolding Zacchaeus for stealing from his neighbors, Jesus invites himself over to the tax collector's house for a party. Profoundly changed by Jesus' love and acceptance, Zacchaeus offers to pay back anyone he has cheated—four times as much! [BOTTOM LINE] The love of Jesus can change things for the better.

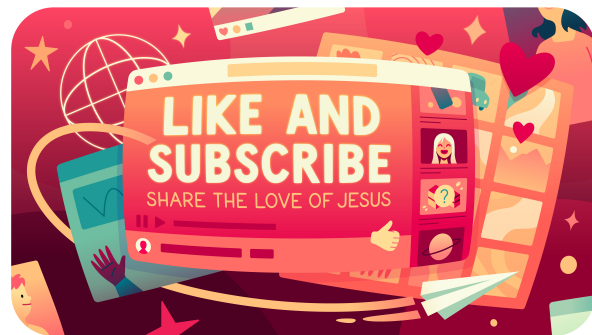

What You Need

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From Doors opening to start of large group - Play intro music in the background as you greet and intentionally engage with students, following the KidCity check-in procedures. Set out a few different stations of toys, puzzles, games, or blocks.

Connect time is spent building relationships with some intentional connecting with kids before Large Group. You can do small activities while you chat together (like coloring or playing or just sit and listen to each other. You can ask your kids relationship-building questions like:

- How old are you?
- Do you have a favorite stuffed animal?
- Do you have a brother, sister, or pet? What are their names?
- What do you like to play at home?
- What's your favorite food/color/animal/ice cream flavor?

"Now, let's quickly go over our KidCity Expectations (rules) so we can make sure that we make the most of our time today: (Don't dwell on these too long, but make sure you review them briefly so we can set everyone up for success.)

1. Be Kind
2. Be Safe
3. Have Fun

"And here are our KidCity Basic Truths:


- I am MADE by God
- I am LOVED by God no matter what
- I am made for a PURPOSE

"So, this month we're talking all about our series, 'Like and Subscribe: Share the Love of Jesus' because when you see something awesome online, you like it and subscribe to it because you don't want to miss a minute of awesomeness. And you want to share that awesomeness with your friends and family too!"

There are 12 game slides, first one is the example, last one the tie breaker. Cut slides if you are running short on time.

"We will talk more about our theme during our Bible Study, but let's start things off this morning with a game! Who knows what a rhyming word is? Right, they are words that have similar sounds. I need everyone to go sit with your small group leaders. This game we will all play together and leaders will keep score. Your groups will look at the picture on the slide and work together to come up with words that match and go with the picture. You will earn 1 point for every word you get that matches the words on the answer slide. Our first slide will be our example."

"Thanks for playing! Let's all stand to worship God together! When we worship, we're reminding ourselves that God's love is real, and that love can change us."

LGL have your Bible opened to the Bible Story, Luke 19:1-10

That verse is so powerful. Jesus told us to love each other the way He loves us.

"Jesus loves people no matter what. Today we're going to learn about the true story in the Bible of a man named Zacchaeus. Zacchaeus had made a lot of bad decisions, so much so that people didn't like him very much. When Zacchaeus met Jesus, he was totally changed—not because Jesus told him to be different, but because Jesus *loved* him. And that's what God's love does, it changes people. When we follow Jesus, His love changes *us*, and it helps us influence others in amazing ways too!

"The same love that Zacchaeus experienced, we can too! And the people we know and meet can experience that love as well!

"Jesus sees us when we mess up. He knows when we make selfish choices. And still, He loves us right where we are—just like He loved Zacchaeus. But Jesus' love doesn't stop there. His love changes us from the inside out. When we start spending time with Jesus, talking to Him, learning about Him, following His example, we begin to change too!

"Maybe you start being kinder to your friends. Maybe you choose to tell the truth instead of hiding it. Maybe you forgive someone who hurt you. That's the love of Jesus at work in your heart. Because when you know Jesus loves you, you don't stay the same, you start to live more like Him every day!

"When you meet Jesus and learn just how much He loves you, His love will change your heart, your choices, and your life. And these changes make it easier to show God's love to other people too."

"Showing the love of Jesus to someone doesn't guarantee that they'll change, but it does open the door."

SLIDE: Bottom Line

"So remember this: **The love of Jesus changes people.**"

Leave Key Question Slide on the screen for Small Group

"Before we look at the key question and head to small group, let's pray."

"Dear God, thank You that Your love is so powerful it changes people from the inside out. Thank You for loving us as we are, but also loving us so much that we don't stay the way we are. Help us to remember Your deep, personal love for us every day, just like You showed Zacchaeus. Holy Spirit, would You fill us with Your power so we can boldly share that love with the people around us? We love You, and we pray these in Jesus' name. Amen."

"Here is our key question for this week, How can love change things? Take a minute and think of your answer, you are going to start small groups by talking about your answers."

(Dismiss kids to their small groups. SMALL GROUP LEADERS open with allowing kids to answer the key question: How can love change things?)

Open small group by discussing key question.

What You Do:


- Ask: "What was the biggest change you saw in Zacchaeus after he met Jesus?" (*He went from selfish and greedy to generous and fair.*)
- Show the group the water bottle. Tell them this is the "Zacchaeus Bottle Flip Challenge."
- Let kids take turns trying to flip the water bottle and have it land standing up.
- Explain that just like flipping the water bottle can completely change its position, Jesus' love completely flipped Zacchaeus's life around.

What You Say:

"These look so great! You can hang this on a door to help everyone remember to share the love of Jesus. Zacchaeus's life was changed so much by Jesus' love that he wanted to make things right. He promised

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to give half of what he owned to the poor and to pay back four times the amount to anyone he had cheated! He learned that **[Bottom Line]** the love of Jesus can change things for the better."

What You Do:

- Ask: "What was the biggest change you saw in Zacchaeus after he met Jesus?" (*He went from selfish and greedy to generous and fair.*)
- Show the group the water bottle. Tell them this is the "Zacchaeus Bottle Flip Challenge."
- Let kids take turns trying to flip the water bottle and have it land standing up.
- Explain that just like flipping the water bottle can completely change its position, Jesus' love completely flipped Zacchaeus's life around.
- Discuss questions

What to say:

It's amazing to think about how much Zacchaeus changed in one day. Jesus didn't condemn him or order him to pay everyone back. Jesus simply made it clear how much He loved him. Jesus looked up into the sycamore-fig tree and said, 'Zacchaeus, come down at once. I must stay at your house today' (Luke 19:5 NIV). That love transformed him from the inside out. Zacchaeus went from being someone nobody trusted to someone who was making things right and being generous, promising to pay back four times the amount he took. It's proof that **[Bottom Line]** the love of Jesus can change things for the better."

- Discuss the following questions:
 - Zacchaeus climbed a tree just to see Jesus. What do you think made him so eager to see Jesus—and what might that say about what was missing in his life?
 - Why do you think Jesus chose to spend time with Zacchaeus when everyone else disliked him?
 - How do you think Zacchaeus felt when Jesus called him by name and wanted to come to his house?
 - What does this story show you about how Jesus sees people—especially those who have made wrong choices?
 - Zacchaeus didn't just feel loved—he changed. Why do you think experiencing Jesus' love made Zacchaeus want to make things right instead of being told to?
 - The story says that the love of Jesus changes people. How has knowing that Jesus loves you—no matter what—changed the way you see yourself or treat others?
