
Matthew 8:5-13

where humility, mercy and trust in God matter most.




Jesus said: "Blessed are those who are humble, they will be given the Earth".




When Jesus finished He and His friends returned to Capernaum. As he entered the town, a Roman commander approached Him.



The commander said: "Lord, my servant lies at home and can't move. He is suffering terribly".




Jesus had healed many people, but this man was different:




(1) Rome had conquered and ruled over the Jewish people. The Romans were seen as the enemy, and




(2) He wasn't just any soldier, he was a commander - A powerful Roman.



Jesus said back to the commander, " Shall I come and heal him?"




To the crowd this felt completely upside-down, but Jesus did not hesitate to offer help.


but just say the word and my servant will be healed".




The commander recognized that as important as he was, Jesus is in charge of everything.

Many will come from East and West and take their place in the Kingdom of heaven. But only those who only think they belong will be thrown outside."




It isn't your family line, where you live or how good you are that brings you into God's Kingdom;




It's faith in Jesus - trusting His power to change us.




Jesus said to the commander, "Go, it will be done just as you believe it would."



When the commander got home, he discovered his servant had been healed at the very moment Jesus spoke.




The commander trusted that God is most important and most powerful.
