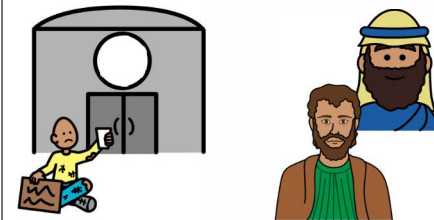
Acts 3-4

Believers gathered together sharing meals and praying on the temple courts. Peter and John were now leaders in the new church.



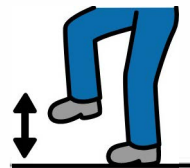
One afternoon, at 3 o'clock, they went to the temple to pray. They saw a man who was asking for money.



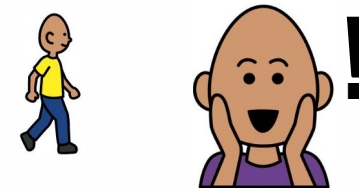
This man was more than 40 years old and had never been able to walk. He thought Peter was going to give him some money.

He went on to explain how Jesus fulfilled everything that the prophets had spoken.



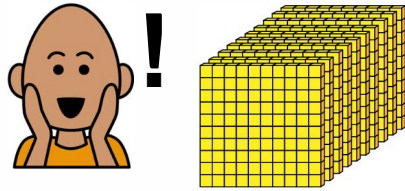
"God raised up Jesus, who served Him and God sent Him first to you. He did it to bless you. He wanted to turn each of you from your evil ways", said Peter.

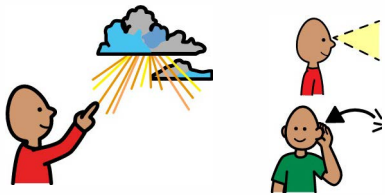

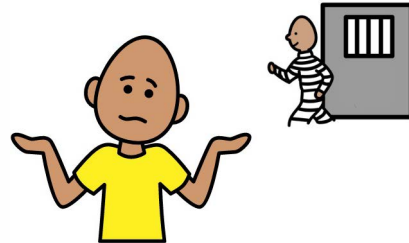
At last the leaders decided - that they couldn't deny what had happened but they needed to stop it.

Both Peter and John said, "Which is right by God's point of view? Shall we listen to you or to God? We have to speak of the things we have seen and heard."



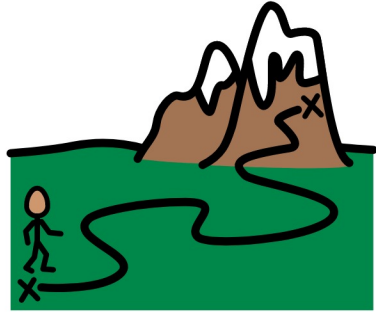
The religious leaders could not figure out what to do with John and Peter so they let them go.
