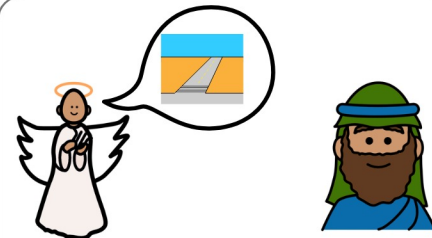
Acts 8:26-40

God sent a message to Philip through an angel. "Go south to the desert road that goes from Jerusalem to Gaza", said the angel.



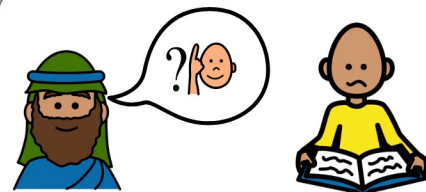
Philip set to go. He wasn't alone on that stretch of desert road. An important man from Ethiopia (Africa) traveled to Jerusalem to worship God.



This man was struggling to understand Jewish Scriptures as he rode along.



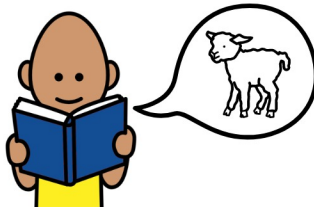
The Holy Spirit prompted Philip to go to the chariot and stay near it.

The man pointed out, "How can I? I need someone to help explain it to me." The official invited Philip to sit in the chariot with him.



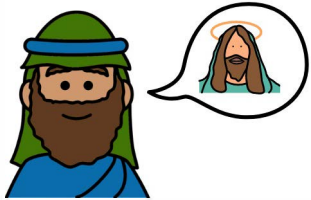
The man was reading - "He was lead like a sheep to be killed just as lambs are silenced while their wool is being cut off."



He did not open His mouth when He was treated badly. He was refused a fair trial, His life was cut off."



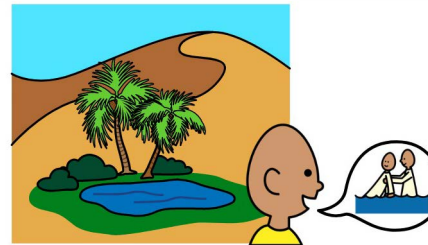
The official wanted to know who the prophet was talking about.



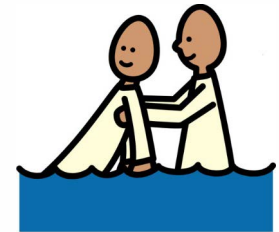
Philip knew that Isaiah was talking about Jesus. How Jesus would give up His life for all of us. Philip explained the story of Jesus to the Ethiopian man.



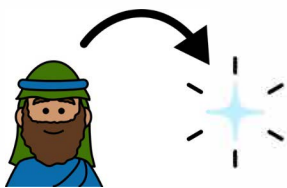
The man was amazed and believed everything Philip told him about Jesus.



When the chariot neared an oasis, the Ethiopian man asked if he could be baptized.



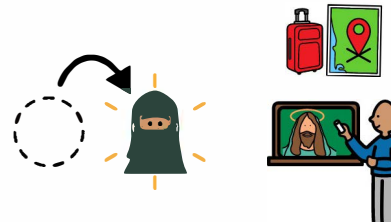
Philip baptized the official as a sign that he now believed in and wanted to follow Jesus.



The Holy Spirit whisked Philip away.

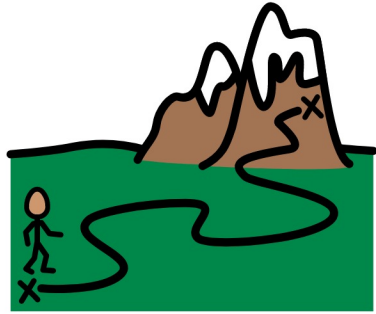


The official continued his journey home and he was filled with joy.



Philip appeared in the town of Azotus and traveled throughout the region teaching the good news about Jesus.

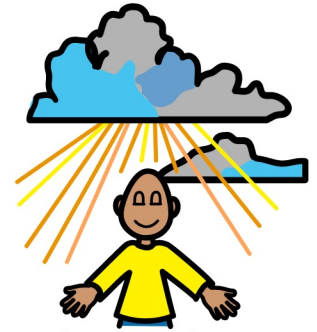
