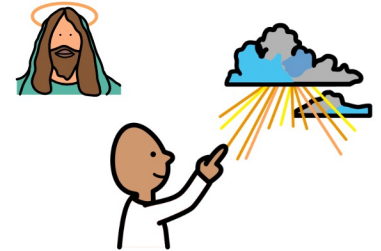
Luke 15:1-7



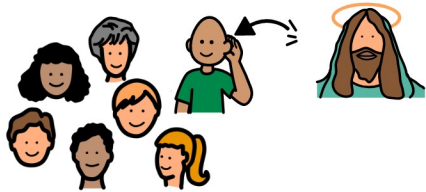
Luke was a Doctor who traveled with the Apostle Paul.

Jesus did not turn away from people who were outsiders or those who had broken God's laws. Instead, He invited everyone to learn about God's love for them.



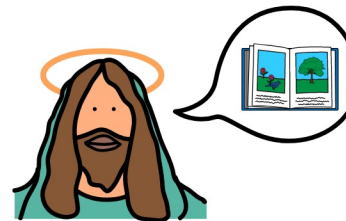
One day, as Jesus was teaching a group of tax collectors and other people who had done wrong things, religious leaders began to grumble to each other.



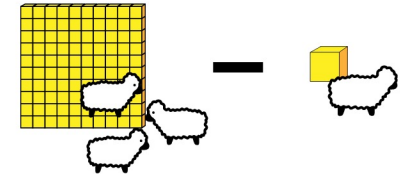
The religious leaders said to each other, "This man actually welcomes sinners. He can eat with them."

Jesus knew what they were thinking, so He told them a parable, a story.

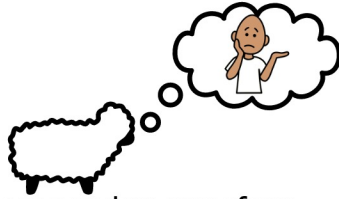


Jesus said, "Suppose one of you has 100 sheep and loses 1 of them."

Won't he leave the 99 in the open country? Won't he go and look for the 1 lost sheep until he finds it?"



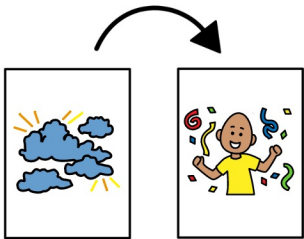
If a sheep wanders away from the flock, it is helpless. The shepherd in Jesus' story could decide to leave the lost sheep on its own.



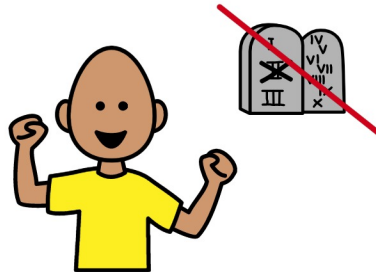
But the shepherd had great compassion for the lost sheep so he goes out into the wild and searches far and wide, until he finds it.



When he finds it, he will joyfully put it on his shoulders and go home. He will call his friends and rejoice.



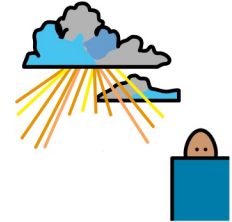
"I tell you, it will be the same in heaven", Jesus said to the religious leaders.

God is like the shepherd.

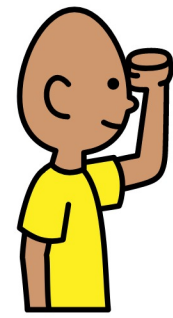


He loves us so much that He sets aside everything to come and find us, even when we are lost and helpless.
